Schooling Support System

The City has a system to support parents whose children are unable to go to elementary or junior high school because of financial reasons. It helps them by offering fees for school meals or school supplies. The parents are also required to come under either one of the following conditions to get this support.

1. Being on welfare.
2. Welfare has been put off or stopped.
3. Citizen's tax is not imposed or has been reduced.
4. Individual enterprise tax or the fixed property tax has been reduced.
5. The premium of National Pension has been exempted or National Health Insurance tax has been reduced or its date of the payment has been postponed.
6. Child dependent allowance is provided.
7. Other financial reasons

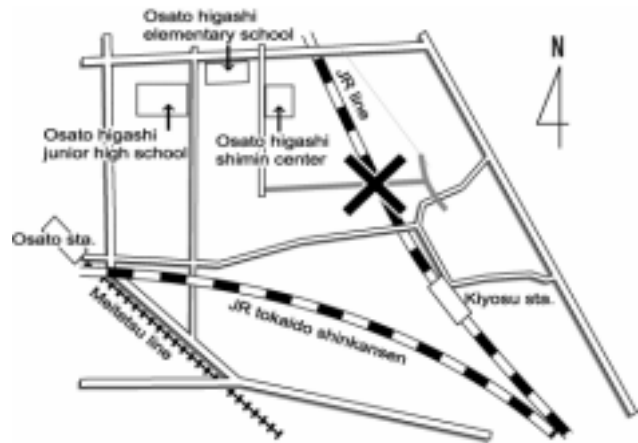
