GENERAL INFO

Light Vehicle Tax Declaration

The owners of light vehicles, motorcycles, mini-cars, special small-sized cars, and small two-wheeled vehicles should pay attention to the following:

1. You should make a declaration even if you are not using your vehicle, because tax will be imposed on you in the following year. Please declare your vehicle as soon as possible.
2. If you are using a light vehicle registered under a former owner (who has transferred the vehicle to you or has died), you must re-register the vehicle under your own name. Please declare your vehicle as soon as possible.

If the required procedures are not carried out, some problems such as being taxed indefinitely may occur.

In addition, a light-vehicle tax is imposed on owners on April 1st of every year.

So there is no taxation, refund for registration, or declaration for change on or after April 2nd. That means the yearly tax for a disused car should be paid.
