GENERAL INFO

Medical Expenses Supply for kokumin kenko hoken insured

In the case that you are paying 100 percent of the medical fees as stated below, 70~90 percent of those should be paid back to you.

1. consultation fee

In the case that the insured had a doctor's consultation in a medical institution without a kokumin kenko hokensho (a health insurance card) in an emergency or for some private reasons, except for the case of traffic accidents (by others) and medical examinations.

2. medical equipment

Corsets, joint equipment, and other medical equipment for medical treatments approved by a doctor (not including any crutches, glasses, and equipment for cosmetic surgeries and so on.)

Apply: Submit the following documents and a hokensho (an insurance card) to hokennenkin-ka in City Hall.

1. medical fee: shinsatsu hoshu meisaisho (a receipt for medical consultation fee) and receipts
2. medical equipment: doctor's certifications and receipts.

* *RMK:* Medical expenses to be transferred to your bank account. Your number of bank account is needed
