There's been an earthquake ! ---- what should you do ?

----- Useful Advice for coping with Disasters -----

There is no knowing when and where such a big earthquake like a M.8 will happen. When an earthquake occurs, momentary decisions might cost you your life. Don't be confused and act calmly such situations.

[Home]

- Crawl under a table or have a cushion on your head.
- Keep away from the furniture or lighting equipments. They could fall, drop or break.
- Turn off the fire. Cut the gas off at the main line and pull out the connection at the outlet.
- Don't walk about in bare feet lest you should be injured by glass pieces.

[Office building or working place]

- Don't rush out of the room but immediately stay under a desk or a working table. Defend yourself against such fixtures as big lockers and OA machines on the desk which could fall or drop.
- When you have huge machines which could fall, drop or explode, immediately get away. Perform an emergency stop during operations, and don't forget to turn off the lights.

[Train or bus]

- Hold on to a strap with both your hands.
- Be sure to follow the crew's direction calmly and obediently.
